- Since January 2017, we've lost 7 employees that made a combined total of \$85 an hour
- We've hired 4 new employees making a combined total of \$42 an hour which is a net savings of \$43 an hour
- We'd like to use \$22 of this savings and split it between 24 of our loyal and dedicated City employees

Mr. Green also stated approximately 60 water leaks has been repaired since November 2016.
