Mayor Davis made recommendation to purchase light pole for \$576.00 that was damaged at the Graysville Heights Ballpark.

Councilmember Teeter moved to purchase light pole for the Graysville Heights Ballpark for \$576.00. Motion seconded by Councilmember Lauderdale and carried.

Mayor Davis presented cooperation agreement for the Graysville Heights Grant project for lights from Jefferson County.

City Attorney, Leslie Klasing stated she has reviewed the agreement but still have questions for Jefferson County.

Councilmember Teeter moved to table cooperation agreement with Jefferson County for further review. Motion seconded by Councilmember Shaw and carried.

Mayor Davis stated that Mr. Justin Gilliam will be going to part-time with the City after taking full-time job with Vestavia Hills.

City Attorney, Leslie Klasing gave results of bid opening of Wildland Gear grant in which two bids were received from Bonaventure Company for \$48,126.00 and NAFCO for

\$47,832.00 for 24 sets, however the grant actually funds 25 sets. The Fire Chief contacted the low bidder NAFCO and they have agreed to include the other set for an additional \$768.00.

Councilmember Lauderdale moved to approve lowest bid from NAFCO for \$47,832.00 for 24 sets per recommendation from City Attorney. Motion seconded by Councilmember Armstrong and carried.

Mayor Davis presented quote from Fire Department for ram mount-cases to mount iPads for \$370.00.

Councilmember Teeter moved to approve quote from Fire Department for ram mount-cases to mount iPads for \$370.00. Motion seconded by Councilmember Hawthorne and carried.

Mayor Davis presented the following quotes for gas safety brochures:
