Chairman Lauderdale announced that Birmingham Waterworks rates will increase 2.9 percent; therefore the Graysville Waterworks customers increase will affect only the customers who use over the minimum of 3000 gallons.

Tommy Greene, Comptroller stated the increase will adjust rates to 3.9 percent or .04 per 100 gallons on customers who use over 3000 gallons.

Mrs. Irwin moved to increase water rates to 3.9 percent or .04 per 100 gallons on customers who use over 3000 gallons per month effective January 2018. Motion seconded by Mr. Saint. Roll call votes as follows:
